

# Surveys on the Training Effects and Job-Creating Assistance for Young Farmers at Kao-Ping Areas

## Abstract

Due to the changes of social and economic structure, the aged labor and shortage of labor became the problem in agricultural production. For providing young farmers for creating their in farm job, several training courses and job-creating assistances has been given. To understand the training effects and assistances in creating jobs for young farmers, a survey was carried out.

Results showed that 80.6% of trainees were satisfied with the training courses given by agricultural extension agencies. For improving management techniques and job-creating assistances, a total of 95.18 and 66.27% of young farmers were satisfied, respectively.
