

Trials on the Bean Planter Attached to the Rice Combine Harvester

Summary

Labor, time, and costs can be saved when using bean planter attached to rice combine harvester to sow bean seeds followed by the harvesting of rice plants. Based on the trials conducted during 1985 and 1986, about 50 minutes per 0.1 hectare were required for harvesting rice and sowing beans at the same time. However, this machine can not be used when too much water in the paddy field. Also, only banded sowing can be applied when using this machine.
